CITY AREA

Harold Boas Gardens

Deli Street, West Perth

Manicured traditional gardens with bridge and waterfall. Bookings necessary with Perth City Council (9265 3333) and a fee is charged. Popular for civil marriage ceremonies.

Queens Gardens

Nelson Street, East Perth

Traditional gardens with bridges over lily ponds. Bookings necessary with Perth City Council (9265 3333) and a fee is charged. If there is a sporting event on at the WA Cricket ground then there maybe a problem with parking.

Wishing Well near War Memorial, Fraser Avenue

Photos taken with the city skyline in the background are always appreciated by relatives and friends outside WA. More suitable for a few quick photographs just of the bride and groom before moving to a more traditional setting such as the Botanic Gardens.

Kings Park

Botanic Gardens/Pioneer Women's Memorial

Wonderful garden setting with a variety of backgrounds. * Highly Recommended

Hyde Park

Glendower Street, Highgate

Old fashioned park with lake, beautiful soft lighting through weeping willow trees with lake background. Hyde Park is fantastic in November when the Jacarandas are in full bloom and looking stunning - its like walking on a sea of purple & looks fab in photos. * Highly Recommended

Ministry of Education and Advanced Manufacturing Technology Centre

Royal Street, East Perth

Often used by fashion photographers where the backdrop of ultra modern buildings enables creative and different photographs. Small garden area where back lit photographs taken under the trees in autumn and spring are attractive.

Victoria Gardens

Corner Royal Street & Trafalgar Road, East Perth

New Park in the East Perth redevelopment area overlooking the Claisebrook inlet, Attractive location with variety of settings.

Narrow Interchange

Mounts Bay Road

Garden and lake setting enables a wide variety of photographs to be taken with garden, lake or city skyline backgrounds. Kings Park is within easy walking distance over the footbridge.

Park at Foot of King's Park

Mounts Bay Road

Located east of the old Swan Brewery complex, park is excellent for photographs in autumn when leaves are on the ground.

Parliament House

Harvest Terrace, West Perth

Various buildings and garden settings at front and rear of building and scope for photographs with city buildings as backdrop. Popular and successful location.

Constitutional Centre and Old Observatory

Corner Havelock Street and Parliament Place, West Perth

Well restored turn of the century buildings provide a good architectural backdrop.

Major Holding Building

23 Outram Street (corner Ord Street), West Perth

Lovely Federation house in small, but attractive garden setting. Private property – be discreet.

NORTHERN SUBURBS**Pinnaroo Valley Memorial Park**

Off Whitfords Avenue, Padbury

Pleasant lawn, park and bushland setting with tame kangaroos. Variety of locations. * Highly Recommended

Cockman House

South west corner Wanneroo and Ocean Reef Roads

Settlers' cottage with old fashioned garden and picket fence for rustic photos. Book through Wanneroo Council (9405 5000). * Highly Recommended

Botanic Golf

25 Burns Beach Road, Wanneroo

Magnificent manicured traditional gardens, wide variety of settings. Privately owned and fee charged prior arrangement necessary on 9405 1475.

Joondalup

Central Park, Grand Boulevard

Developing gardens with lake and waterfalls. Close to Edith Cowan University who have lovely gardens and building where photographs can be taken.

Pine Plantation

Wanneroo Road, Wanneroo

Pine plantation offers a different backdrop for photos.

WESTERN SUBURBS**University of WA**

Mounts Bay Road, Crawley

Variety of settings garden, poolside and colonnade. Bookings necessary (9380 3838) and a fee is charged. Parking situated at Car Park 20 beneath Lawrence Jackson Art Gallery at rear of sunken gardens. Popular venue and unavailable during examinations period (November).

Claremont

Mrs Herbert's Park near Claremont Museum, Victoria Avenue

Photographs with garden and riverside settings amongst colonial museum buildings. * Highly Recommended

Cottesloe Civic Centre

Broome Street, Cottesloe

Variety of photo possibilities in garden and terrace settings. Fees are charged and prior booking essential. Very popular place and other parties maybe queuing up for photos.

Scotch College Administration Building

Corner Shenton Road and Australind Street, Swanbourne

Federation house and lawn settings. Private property – be discreet.

Perry Lakes

Perry Lakes Drive, Floreat Park
Bushland settings with lakes.

Subiaco Civic Centre

Hamersley Road, Subiaco
Pleasant gardens and trees.

Mosman Park Civic Centre

Bayview Terrace, Mosman Park
Pleasant rose gardens and avenue of pines trees.

Mosman Gardens

Adelma Road, Dalkeith
Lawn area, weeping willows and rustic settings.

Mosman Park

Green Place Reserve, Chidley Way
Romantic location with lawns and jetty. * Highly Recommended

Catholic Education Centre/St Michael the Archangel Chapel

50 Ruislip Street, Leederville
Traditional Church and old convent with stone arches set in pleasant gardens. Bookings are necessary with Catholic Education Office.

Mabel Talbot Park

Jersey Street, Jolimont
Attractive sheltered garden and weeping willows.

Booragoon Garden City Shopping Centre

Marmion Street
Attractive sheltered garden and ornamental lake.

Cannington Woodloes Homestead

Woodloes Street
Colonial style house and attractive gardens and museum. Ideal for civil wedding ceremony, booking necessary with caretaker on 9231 0610. * Highly Recommended

Como – McDougall Park

Ley Street
Pleasant park with shady trees and lake.

Fremantle Museum and Arts Centre

Finnerty Street
Colonial limestone building and gardens. Closes 5pm unless special arrangements have been previously made.

Fremantle Traffic Bridge, Riverside Road, East Fremantle

Wonderful and interesting photographs on the walkway over the river beneath this bridge. Recommended you call briefly here in addition to using a more traditional settings.

Swan river and Perth city buildings as a backdrop or amongst trees and lawn area.

Park and ornamental lake opposite casino.

Harow Street Whiteman
Lake and parkland setting. Old wagons and machinery ideal for photos.
